SCOPE OF CONTEST

Contestants will demonstrate photo editing skills using Adobe Photoshop on a Macintosh computer. Using supplied digital images, software and hardware, contestants will demonstrate their digital imaging skills and knowledge by completing a project requiring them to repair, adjust, manipulate and combine digital images. You **MUST** have experience with Photoshop in order to participate in this event.

To take place in this event, instructors must provide students first and last name along with their email addresses by February 28, 2024, to sgeorge@fcoe.org. The student information will be sent to the event manager at Fresno City College to generate student access to the Adobe software.

NUMBER OF COMPETITORS

Individual event, limited to 22 competitors.

RULES AND PROCEDURES

1. You **MUST** have experience with **Adobe Photoshop on a Mac** in order to participate in this event.
2. Contestants must arrive by 9:30 am to the designated classroom.
3. Contestants will be seated at stations with their school name.
4. Instructors will inform contestants what they need to do with the 2 photos they will work on. Contestants will color correct, dodge and burn, take out dust spots, move elements from one photo to another, sharpen and make a professional image.
5. By 9:45 am contestants will start the competition.
6. Competition ends at 11:00 am.
7. Instructors will judge the images for a first, second and third place finish.
8. Only supplied hardware, software and images may be used.

JUDGING CRITERIA

The skill areas tested may include, but are not limited to, the following areas:

- Image retouching and restoration
- Brightness, contrast, tonal, color and sharpness adjustment
- Complex selections
- Creating a composite image from various images
- Adjusting file size, resolution, canvas size, format
- Opening, creating, saving and naming files
- Use of tools, palettes, layers, etc
