# **Event Specifications**

## SCOPE OF CONTEST

Each contestant will take several three-minute timings using PC's and windows software.

#### NUMBER OF COMPETITORS

Individual event, limited to 27 competitors. <u>Fresno ROP reserves the right to modify enrollment due to limited spaces available.</u>

## **RULES AND PROCEDURES**

- 1. General directions will be given to all contestants.
- 2. Each contestant will be allowed two, one-minute warm up timings. This will be followed by two-minute and three-minute timings. ERRORS ARE NOT CORRECTABLE. Contestants may not cancel and restart any timing.
- 3. Contestants will start each timing when the instructor signals.
- 4. Contestants must strike the tab key once to indent paragraphs only and strike the enter/return key once at the end of a paragraph (word-wrap ends lines automatically). Use **one** space after a period.
- 5. Once the competition starts, there must be no conversations/talking to persons outside the competition arena; teachers, coaches or parents, or between the competitors.
- 6. Scoring is completely automated. The highest words per minute with 96% or better accuracy will determine the winners. Timings will not be averaged. Timings with less than 96% accuracy will not be printed. Speed ties will be broken by the highest accuracy.

#### JUDGING CRITERIA

- 1. Keyboarding speed
- 2. Keyboarding accuracy
- 3. Ability to follow directions

#### **EQUIPMENT AND MATERIALS**

  - a. Personal computers and printers
  - b. Typing tables (standard typing height)
  - c. Adjustable chairs
  - d. Copies of warm-up and test
